**Tournament Notes:**

1. PLEASE NOTE: This is a MEDAL tournament. No advice permitted except as to information on the Rules, distance or matters of public information, such as the position of hazards or the flagstick on the putting green.
2. Women will play from the Yellow tees and men will play from the WHITE tees.
3. Closest to the Hole will be on all par-3 holes; stick a tee in the ground to mark your ball. A tee will be placed laying on it's side directly behind the in the event that nobody hits the green.
4. The Rules Committee for this tournament will be Joe Kraynik, John Glennon, and Doug Ackerman. If you are on the course and are unsure of a ruling, you may play a secondary ball into the green. Just make sure you can mark the secondary ball so that you can positively identify each one. If you need a rules interpretation, please speak with these individuals AFTER you complete your round, but BEFORE you sign your card.
5. All players must sign the score card. By doing so, all players are verifying that the score recorded for each hole is correct. You are **not** responsible for the mathematics resulting in your total score.
6. The 10 stroke mercy rule will be in effect.

**COVID Notes and rule adjustments:**

Flagsticks stay in the hole and a plastic bumper will be placed in the hole about 1-2 inches below the surface of the cup which will allow the ball to be holed and the golfer to retrieve the ball without touching the flag or the sides/bottom of the hole. Due to the design of the anti COVID hole arrester, putts can often drop in the hole and bounce out. In the event that this happens, if the general consensus of the group is the ball would normally have gone in the hole, count it as a holed putt. Please be fair!

There are no rakes in the bunkers. As we may encounter inconsistent conditions, you may smooth/level the sand for both location of the ball and your stance, and replace your ball.

We will do the 'Closest To' on all Par 3 holes without the tape measures and the signs we normally use. There will be a tee marking the closest ball in the first group. If none of us hits the green I will lay the tee next to the hole. Each subsequent group can move the tee as needed. People who hit the green should note/remember which holes they moved the tees and notify me when they turn in their scorecards.

I will not have scorecards made up beforehand. Each group should keep their own scorecard; ideally at least 2 so they can compare after the round as usual. A player is responsible for the hole-by-hole scores, not the addition. To limit how much the scorecards are handled we will forego the usual initialing.

The bar is closed so I will collect scorecards on the patio above the 18<sup>th</sup> green. If you do email me the scorecard, remember to include any updates on the par 3's that you hit closest-to and moved the tee.
