

23rd NCGA Senior Four-Ball Net Championship | Poppy Hills | September 13-14, 2021

First played in 1999, the NCGA Senior Four-Ball Net Championship is two-person, better-ball handicap event for all senior NCGA members. ENTRIES CLOSE: August 1, 2021 ENTRY FEE: \$270 per team. Club officials must register teams.

QUALIFYING for the 2021 Senior Four-Ball Net Championship will take place August 18-28 at the following courses: Poppy Ridge GC (August 18) | Baylands GL (August 19) | Haggin Oaks GC (August 19) | Laguna Seca GR (August 19) | Santa Rosa GCC (August 23) | Peach Tree GCC (August 23) | Metropolitan GL (August 26) | Paradise Valley GC (August 28) | Paso Robles GC (August 28) | Reserve at Spanos Park GC (August 28) ELIGIBILITY: All NCGA member clubs may send up to THREE teams. Multi-members can only represent one club. Players must have reached their 55th birthday on or before September 13, 2021 and have a numeric handicap index listed on their club's Master Report on the date of registration. FORMAT: Four-Ball Stroke Play (Two-Person Better Ball). 18 holes for qualifying. 36 holes, 18 holes per day for the championship proper. Play will be 85% of the course handicap using a maximum handicap index of 18.4 for calculation. All players with valid handicap indexes, including those of 18.5 and above, are eligible but must play to a maximum handicap index of 18.4 for men and 25.4 for women.
